

Notes on the 2022-06-16 WLT assignment

This week's exercise:

- Use the Health and Human Services website to look up hospital data.
- Use Winlink Express to create and send a Hospital Data Reporting Form. This form is to track and share crucial hospital capabilities with other facilities in and around an affected disaster area.

Results

This week we had

- 610 unique participants
- 628 messages
- 15 first time participants this week

So far in 2022, we had 1607 unique participants.

Of the 628 messages received:

- message type: hospital_bed, count: 606 (96.5%)
- message type: rejects, count: 17 (2.7%)
- message type: check_in, count: 3
- message type: ack, count: 1
- message type: ics_213, count: 1

Of the 17 messages rejected:

- reject type: same location, count: 12
- reject type: can't parse lat/lon, count: 2
- reject type: explicit bad location, count: 2
- reject type: unsupported type, count: 1

This exercise was graded.

Here's the "grading key":

- Agency/Group name set to 'ETO Winlink Thursday'. 10 points.
- Contact Phone specified as '555-555-5555'. 10 points.
- Contact Email specified as participant's Winlink address. 10 points.
- Medical/Surgical available filled in or explained. 20 points.
- Critical Care available filled in or explained. 20 points.
- Six other Available Bed fields blank. 10 points if **all** are blank.
- Additional Comments set to 'This is an exercise'. 20 points.

Here's the breakdown of the 606 graded hospital bed messages:

- 100: 395 (65.18%)
- 90: 97 (16.01%)
- 80: 29 (4.79%)
- 70: 34 (5.61%)
- 60: 27 (4.46%)
- 50: 8 (1.32%)
- 40: 9 (1.49%)
- 30: 4 (0.66%)
- 20: 3 (0.50%)

Here's how each question was graded:

- agency/group name: 535(88%) ok, 71(12%) not ok
- contact phone: 525(87%) ok, 81(13%) not ok
- contact email: 561(93%) ok, 45(7%) not ok
- medical/surgical beds: 544(90%) ok, 62(10%) not ok
- critical car beds: 551(91%) ok, 55(9%) not ok
- other beds: 556(92%) ok, 50(8%) not ok
- additional comments: 591(98%) ok, 15(2%) not ok
